REQUIREMENTS: A COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENCY (GED), COPY OF HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT AND 3 LETTERS OF REFERENCE, COPY OF DRIVERS LICENSE must be presented to receive an application. **(Prior applicants must resubmit the above documents)**. You must be **18** years of age and have **a Valid Photo Driver's License without major infractions**. Successful applicants will be required to pass a drug screening. **Veterans, please include a copy of your DD-214.**
